SUBJECT: Adjusted Dates of Loss – 2011 Mid-Spring Storms MS

The 2011 Mid-Spring Storms produced torrential rain and widespread flood damage in Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, and Tennessee. In Clearinghouse Bulletin W-11028 dated May 11, 2011, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) assigned FICO numbers to track the claims arising from this event. FEMA has now adjusted the Dates of Loss for the event.

This Bulletin does not include losses from the Garrison Dam, ND, flood-in-progress triggered by dam water release and resulting flooding on June 1, 2011, affecting the Missouri River below Garrison Dam, ND, to St. Louis, MO.

Below are the updated “Dates of Loss” begin dates at the county level for the state of Mississippi. Three additional counties were added: Humphries, Sharkey, and Yazoo. These counties were not included in the list in Bulletin W-11039, as they are not located on the Mississippi River but are located on tributaries that feed into the Mississippi River:
