The 2011 North Dakota Late-Spring Storms produced torrential rain and flood damage in North Dakota. As a result, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has assigned a FICO number to track the claims arising from this event.

The rains and melting snow have caused widespread flooding that extends the length of the Souris River Basin from the Canadian border through the North Dakota counties of Renville, Ward, McHenry, and Bottineau. As a result, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has determined the following start dates for dates of loss for these counties.

**“Dates of Loss” begin dates at the county level, geographically sorted from north to south following the Souris River.**
