SUBJECT: Adjusted Date of Loss – CT, DE, DC, GA, MD, MA, NJ, NY, PA, RI, SC, VT, VA – FICO 277-289

Hurricane Irene has produced torrential rain and widespread flood damage in Connecticut, Delaware, District of Columbia, Georgia, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, Vermont, and Virginia. In Clearinghouse Bulletin W-11061, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) assigned FICO numbers 277 – 289 to track the claims arising from this event. FEMA has now adjusted the Date of Loss for the event, as shown below.
