SUBJECT: Adjusted Dates of Loss FICO 264 – LA 2011 Louisiana  
Mid-Spring Storms

The 2011 Louisiana Mid-Spring Storms produced torrential rain and flood damage in Louisiana. In Clearinghouse Bulletin W-11028 dated May 11, 2011, Clearinghouse Bulletin W-11039 dated June 20, 2011, and Clearinghouse Bulletin W-11073 dated September 5, 2011, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) assigned a FICO number and date-of-loss range to track flood claims arising from this event. FEMA has now adjusted the Dates of Loss for the event.
