SUBJECT: Transfer Procedure for Subsidized Policies

This memorandum provides additional clarifications to Bulletin W-13016 dated March 29, 2013, regarding the transfer of a National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) policy eligible for Pre-FIRM subsidized rates from one insurer to another at the time of renewal, where the transfer is initiated by an agent or the insured.

Bulletin W-13016 indicated that transfers of Pre-FIRM subsidized policies would remain eligible for Pre-FIRM subsidized rating based on the eligibility established by the previous insurer. NFIP insurers are required to document their underwriting files with a copy of the previous carrier's Declarations page as evidence of Pre-FIRM subsidy eligibility. This memorandum clarifies that where the previous carrier's Declarations page indicates a policy effective date on or after July 6, 2012, the receiving insurer must obtain evidence of continuous coverage with Pre-FIRM subsidized rates effective before July 6, 2012. In some cases, this will require Declarations pages for multiple policy years.
