

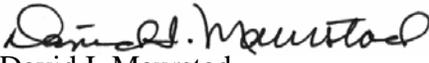

SUBJECT: State Actions Taken to Implement Flood Insurance Training
Requirements of the Flood Insurance Reform Act of 2004
(FIRA) Section 207

The State Departments of Insurance are taking various actions to establish training requirements for insurance agents who sell flood insurance, as outlined in Section 207 of the FIRA (Public Law 108-264). To assist the Write Your Own (WYO) Companies and their agents, FEMA created a database to record the initiatives the States are taking to implement the FIRA flood insurance training requirements.

I am requesting that you and your agents review this information on FEMA's website http://www.fema.gov/business/nfip/state_actions.shtm. The material is a representation of documents published by various States. If you would like copies of the actual documents, please contact the State Department of Insurance that prepared the material.
