SUBJECT: Reminder about Renewal Mailing Requirements under the FIRA 2004

WYO Clearinghouse Bulletin W-05043 and others have provided guidance to the Write Your Own companies regarding implementation of the Title II requirements of the Flood Insurance Reform Act of 2004 (FIRA 2004).

This is to remind you that there is a difference in the materials that must be distributed to policyholders at policy issuance and at subsequent renewals. In accordance with normal insurance industry practice, the policy contract is distributed only at initial policy issuance, while the other forms (Cover Letter, Summary of Coverage, and Declarations Page) are distributed at each renewal.
